Reporting to the Finance Director, the Finance Business Partner is responsible for delivering high quality, timely financial analysis, reporting and insights at organisational and team level. Building strong relationships with budget holders across 38 Degrees, the Finance Business Partner will raise the level of institutional knowledge in finance, encourage good decision making through robust processes and ensure that forward thinking financial insight is a key tool used by teams to achieve their goals.

This job description describes the role of Finance Business Partner. The 38 Degrees team works in a culture of togetherness, passion for our issues and determination to win, so from time to time the team will be expected to perform activities outside of their normal role.
